Background and Lyrics

BACKGROUND AND SCRIPTURE

"The Blessing" is rooted in the ancient priestly blessing the Lord gave to Moses for Aaron and his sons to speak over Israel.

This song is not simply saying, "God, be good to you." It carries something deeper: covenant identity, divine covering, generational promise, and the name of the Lord resting upon His people.

In Numbers 6, after the blessing is spoken, the Lord says that His name would be placed upon the children of Israel. That is the heart of this song. It is about the Lord turning His face toward His covenant people, keeping them, giving them peace, and blessing their children after them.

As you hear this song, receive it as more than music. Receive it as a blessing spoken over you, your family, your children, and the work God has placed in your hands.

As we leave this Gathering and return to our homes, workplaces, families, and daily lives, may the Lord's name rest upon us. May His face shine upon us. May His peace go with us. And may we carry the covenant forward, not only in what we believe, but in how we live, gather, build, and help redeem Zion.
